Camp Information

Location: All ISI camps will be held at 4330 N. Michigan Rd. in both the Blackwell building (closest to the road) and the Taurel building (farthest from the road).

Registration Fee: There is a one time, \$10 registration fee for each individual camper. This is a nonrefundable fee.

Extended Care:

Morning Care: 7:30-9:00 am \$30 per week per child

Afternoon care: 3:00-6:00 pm. \$50 per week per child

Both am & pm care \$70 per week per child

Extended Care Staff: Our extended care staff is chosen from members of ISI's child care staff.

Each of them exemplifies the ISI core values of respect, effort and responsibility.

Sibling Discount: For each additional sibling enrolled, there will be a 10% discount on all fees.

Payment: Payments made by check should be made payable to the International School of Indiana or ISI.

Those wishing to pay by credit card should mark the appropriate box on the registration form and you will be contacted to complete the transaction.

Payment Policy: All camps must be paid in full on the Wednesday prior to the camp's start date.

Cancellation: The International School of Indiana reserves the right to cancel any session due to insufficient registration. A refund, minus the registration fee of \$10.00, will be made.

Families who wish to cancel a camper's enrollment must do so two weeks prior to the start of that camp, otherwise a 20% fee will be assessed.

Medication: All medications, over the counter and prescription, are to be left with the Camp Director.

Please include specific instructions with each medication. All medications will be administered by an adult.

Field Trips: All campers must have a signed permission slip on file in order to participate in campsponsored filed trips.

Pictures: Unless we have a letter stating the contrary, the International School of Indiana will assume that your child may be photographed and all pictures may be used for publication by the ISI Summer Camp Program.
